<u>Curriculum Progression</u> <u>Strand: to master practical skills in textiles.</u>

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Foundation stage:

Children can join textiles using glue.



<u>Key Vocabulary</u> join, decorate

<u> Y1:</u>

Children can use running stitch.



<u>Key Vocabulary</u> binca, running stitch

Children can shape textiles using a template and join textiles using over stitching.



<u>Key Vocabulary</u> over stítch, template <u>Y3:</u>

Children can join textiles using running stitch and overstitching and add decorations.



<u>Key Vocabulary</u> decoration, wadding

Children can join fabrics using appropriate stitching and add appliqué decorations.



<u>Key Vocabulary</u> back stítch, applíqué

*Y*5:

Children can create objects which employ a seam allowance.



<u>Key Vocabulary</u> seam allowance, blanket stítch, techníque <u>Y6:</u>

Children can join textiles using a combination of stitching techniques and choose decorations to fit the purpose.



<u>Key Vocabulary</u> hem, pín, tack

Mastery:

Children can use qualities of materials to create suitable visual and tactile effects in the decoration of textiles.
