



Curriculum Learners

- As historians, we will produce a local history study (we will look at changes, which happened over the 80's and how it affected Yorkshire Margaret Thatcher in power, miners' strike, Humber Bridge opening how did this impact on us locally?).
- As geographers, we will use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries (locate areas in the UK affected by the miners' strike/ Falkland war).
- As designers and artists, we will learn about great artists, architects and designers in history (artists/fashion designers/designers and architects from the 80s). We will design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria select from and use a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks [for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing] evaluate their ideas and products against design criteria (design an outfit fit for the 80s/vinyl sleeve for a record)
- As musicians, we will appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians
 - We will develop an understanding of the history of music (look at the changes of music from the decade before to the decade after).
- British Values What are they? How did they link to the main events in the 80s?

- As musicians, we will play and perform using musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency and control.
